Women need to be strong



to know this It is not. Every women need to know of the laws and constitutions safeguard.

Session II

Adv. Sarangiben Y. Gujarati (Advocate, District Court, Dhule) share experience on Role of Social Worker and advocates regarding women and property rights and its implementation. She said that had stopped 06 divorces two years ago. To judge is to give to the one who has it. She explained that, how the law gives rights to women in different religions Children of religion are discriminated against. She focuses on various case studies and cases of women and shares her ground level experience. The above detailed laws have been framed since 1956 and in this way, he informed the women about the detailed law of property rights and provisions.

Session III

Dr. Bharat Khandagale,(Assistant Professor in Social Work, JNC College of Social Work, Amlner). He was focused on presence situation of women empowerment and employment. And role of social worker regarding the women's in society who gave excellent information to the girl students and participates women's he said that if women get education, health, support, physical relations, role, discussion in every possible way, then they will be able to realize their own existence and start moving towards empowerment. And education, health, support, physical relations and technical knowledge are key factor of empowerment and employment. Finally he said that, we are the creator of our self.

Session IV

Dr. Ganapat Dhumale, (Assistant Professor in Law, Maniyar Law college, Jalgaon) discussed on Role of Social Worker in Marriage, Divorce Act and linkages between marriage and divorce act. He briefly discussed Hindu Marriage Act 1955, Special Marriage Act 1954, Child Marriage Prohibition Act, Dowry Prohibition Act. India ranks eighth in the world in terms of child marriage. At present, according to the new rules, the age of marriage for a girl is 21 and the age of marriage for a boy is 21.Hindu marriage law applies to all remaining religions except Lingayat, Christian, Muslim, Parsi. He gave detailed information about such laws to women. He focus on the marriage law and situation of women's in India.

References


